How it Works

First, register your tree(s) at The Exchange Website. We will gather some basic information about your harvest preference, location and the fruit you will have available.

Self-Harvesters will be given a Harvest Crate to fill when their fruit is in season. Full harvest crates are “Exchanged” for new at the French Town Heritage Hub, 524 N Martin Luther King Jr Blvd (near the Governor’s mansion). You can contact us to arrange for a volunteer to pick up and “Exchange” your crate, too.

If you need help Harvesting your fruit we will gladly arrange for one of gleaning teams to help.
